Organizing well attended workshops from technical to strategic level

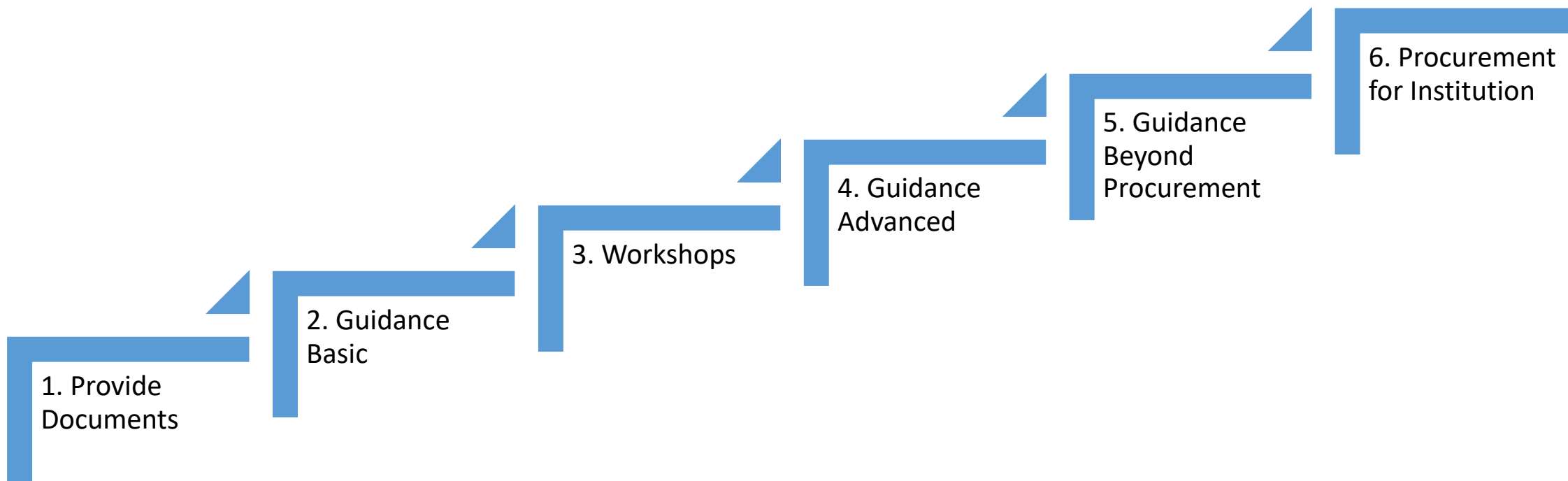
But cannot become full commercial partners
